Dear Parents and Carers,

On Wednesday, we had our first PEN meeting for the term, which all parents and carers were invited to attend. Uniform Shop Changes

We have confirmed with our uniform supplier that **starting next Wednesday 11 May**, uniforms will be delivered to the school for parent or student pick up between 12.00 - 1.00pm on Wednesdays. The uniform shop will be manned by College staff and parent volunteers. All orders must continue to be purchased online.

Parents choosing not to pick up orders at the College or not to allow their students to pick up will pay the \$20 delivery fee or pick up directly from Granville.


